Type or paste your text into this file, but remember to keep the page margins the same as is set here, which is 1.5' all round. Paragraphs are justified (straight-edged) on both left and right. Use single-line spacing and leave a line gap between paragraphs.

The abstract must include a clear indication of the objectives, research problem, hypothesis (if any), methodology, findings, concluding remarks, and key references. The last day for abstract submission is 10.07.2023 before 11.59 p.m. Sri Lanka time (IST). Abstracts should be sent via acs14focj@kdu.ac.lk. The sub-theme of the abstract should be mentioned in the subject field. The body of the email should contain the following details: The sub-theme, title, name of the author(s), author affiliation(s), contact details (email address/es and phone number/s) of the author(s), and the type of submission. Authors whose abstracts are selected will be informed of the same shortly after submission.

There is no fee for submission of an abstract, but if you do not register and pay the outstanding registration fee in full by the deadline of 10th of August 2023, the abstract will not appear in the programme.
